ABOUT THE CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM:

Research is about creating new knowledge. It is a continuous process and requires gradual progression to achieve meaningful results for the benefit of society at large. To meet this challenge, it is necessary to train and equip our young faculty with the latest methodology and tools so that they can comply with the quality standards of research in their respective disciplines. This program on capacity building in research aims to develop and promote research acumen amongst the young faculty in social sciences, including management, and to make them user-friendly with the statistical software available nowadays. The proposed program has been designed to bridge the gap between theory and the practical approach adopted by young academicians in their research progression.

Further, this Two-week capacity-building program in social science research is proposed as an important component for the effective implementation of *National Education Policy-2020* in the eastern region of Uttar Pradesh. It is clearly empathized that the growth and expansion of the social sciences depend on quality research work and the use of appropriate methodology for conducting research in this area. Social Science Research faces the challenge of thoroughly equipping itself to meet the ever-growing needs of the society that is transforming at a rapid pace. Societal problems are assuming wide-ranging complexities.

Under these circumstances, it is necessary to approach research with a preliminary and systematic understanding of the methods in social science research. This is an essential part of social science research, and over a period of time, the methods have expanded enormously in their scope and application.

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE PROPOSED COURSE

The purpose of this Capacity Building Program is to develop our academics by building the capacity of young faculty members. With only twelve working days, the planned capacity-building program is designed to direct faculty members toward certain goals. The key idea behind the program is to enrich the capability of conducting quality research among newly recruited young social science faculty and further bring out their research output into publishable material of high quality in the form of journal articles or books.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

The capacity building Program (CBP) has been designed to achieve the following objectives:

- 1. To create awareness about modern teaching practices and research methodologies.
- 2. To make the faculty participants familiar and friendly with the basic concepts of research methodology by brushing up their basic knowledge on research methodology.
- 3. To make the participants user-friendly with statistical software like SPSS, AMOS, Meta-analysis, and others.
- 4. To give hands-on experience in research to the participants through the field or practical work assigned to them.
- 5. To develop the applied research skills of the participants.
- 6. Further, to maintain and enhance faculty effectiveness and provide further expert instruction and guidance to their students,
- 7. To develop capacity for writing research papers, articles, and books through advanced writing software.

LEARNING OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAM

- 1. After attending CBP, participants will gain an in-depth understanding of research and its implications for the decision-making process.
- 2. Gain a better understanding of how to design a valid research project to answer specific research questions.
- 3. Design reliable and valid questionnaires for the collection of data;
- 4. Use descriptive and predictive statistical tools using robust analytical software, namely SPSS, SEM, AMOS, and R.
- 5. Participants will become familiar with univariate, bivariate, and multivariate statistical techniques.
- 6. Gain a better understanding of academic writing, like research papers, books, articles, etc.

GUIDELINES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS

- a. Duration of the Programme: The Capacity Building Program is scheduled to be held between 5th-17th
 February, 2024. There shall be no off days/holidays during the program.
- Mode of Program: The program is proposed to be conducted in offline mode at Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur only.
- c. Eligibility criteria for the Programme: The Capacity Building Program is intended for young social science permanent faculties of UGC recognized Indian Universities/Deemed University/College of National Importance and ICSSR Research Institutes. Assistant Professor belongs to Psychology, Education, Management, Sociology, Geography, Mass Communication, Economics, Commerce are given preferences for the course.
- d. Program Fees: There is no registration/fooding & lodging fee for the Capacity Building Program.
- e. Number of Seats: The number of seats is limited to 30 (10 Outside the Uttar Pradesh State, 10 Within the State, and 10 Local participants.
- f. Attendance, Assessment, and Participation Certificate: This program will have 49 sessions during 13 days. Attending all 49 sessions is mandatory for participants. The learning of the participants shall be evaluated using daily quizzes, and, presentation of their research assignment. On the aforesaid basis they shall be awarded A, B, C & D Grades. Participants after successful completion of the Program (Securing at least C Grade in evaluation) shall be provided with participation certificate mentioning their grades.
- g. Travel and Accommodation of Participants attending program in person: Outstation participants will be reimbursed for their travel costs as per ICSSR, New Delhi & VBS Purvanchal University rules & regulations. Accommodation to outstation participants will be provided on a twin-sharing basis at the VBS Purvanchal University Guest House/Hostel.

- Applicants must be working as an Assistant Professor or having equivalent position in any recognized university/institute/colleges in Social Science discipline.
- Interested candidates are required to apply on the prescribed format (attached below). They shall also be required to attach their updated CV including all academic details, work experience, and publications and the 200 words write up related to applicants' research area.
